| 9/11 | Moses Is Born | Ex 2:1-10 | God protects Moses from Pharaoh's eradication | Trust that God has a plan for each one of us | "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future." (Jer 29:11) |
| 9/18 | The Burning Bush | Ex 3 | God appears to Moses in the burning bush | Be holy, just as God is holy | But just as he who called you is holy, so be holy in all you do. (1Pet 1:15) |
| 9/25 | The Ten Plagues | Ex 5-12 | God listens to His people's cry for help | Pray to God in times of trouble | The Lord is with me; He is my helper. (Ps 118:7) |
| 10/2 | Crossing the Red Sea | Ex 13-15 | God delivers His people from their enemies | Trust that God will deliver us from our enemies | For He guards the course of the just and protects the way of his faithful ones. (Prov 2:8) |
| 10/9 | Manna and Water | Ex 16-19 | God provides for the needs of His people | Trust God for His provision | And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus. (Phil 4:19) |
| 10/16 | The Ten Commandments | Ex 20 | God gives us His commandments | Keep God's commandments | These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts. (Deut 6:6) |
| 10/23 | The Golden Calf | Ex 32-34 | God punishes those who worship idols | Worship only the true God | You shall have no other gods before me. (Ex 20:3) |
| 10/30 | Balaam and the Bronze Snake | Num 21-24 | God heals those who turn to Him | Believe in Jesus as our Savior | For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. (Jn 3:16) |
| 11/6 | Joshua--the New Leader | Josh 1 | God raises Joshua to be the new leader of God's people | Be strong and courageous | Be strong and courageous. (Josh 1:6) |

| 12/11 | Samson | Judg 13-16 | God delivers His people through Samson | Choose friends carefully | The righteous choose their friends carefully, but the way of the wicked leads them astray. (Prov 12:26) |
| 12/18 | Ruth | Ruth 1:1-4:17 | God blesses Ruth as she follows Naomi in returning home | Follow those who follow God | Where you go I will go, and where you stay I will stay. Your people will be my people and your God my God. (Ruth 1:16) |
