| 1/19 | Jesus Raises a Widow's Son | Lk 7:11-17 | Jesus raises a widow's son from death | Believe Jesus has power over death | I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me will live, even though they die. (Jn |
| 1/26 | Jesus Forgives a Sinful Woman | Lk 7:36-50 | Jesus forgives a sinful woman | Believe Jesus has power to forgive sin | The Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins. (Mk 2:10) |
| 2/2 | The Good Samaritan | Lk 10:25-37 | A Samaritan cares for a Jew | Love your neighbor as yourself | Love your neighbor as yourself. (Lk 7:27) |
| 2/9 | A Wise Choice | Lk 10:38-42 | Mary sits down to listen to Jesus | Take time to listen to Jesus | Keep this Book of the Law always on your lips; meditate on it day and night. (Josh 1:8) |
| 2/16 | A Persistent Friend | Lk 11:1-13 | Jesus teaches the disciples to be persistent in praying | Pray persistently | Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. (Lk 11:9) |
| 2/23 | The Rich Fool | Lk 12:13-34 | The rich fool saves up his treasures and dies | Do not worry about your life | Do not worry about your life, what you will eat; or about your body, what you will wear. (Lk 12:22) |

| 3/9 | The Lost | Lk 15:1-32 | God values the lost | Repent and return to God | Rejoice with me; I have found my lost sheep. (Lk |
| 3/16 | Jesus Heals Ten Lepers | Lk 17:11-19 | Jesus heals ten lepers | Give thanks | Give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus. (1Thes 5:18) |
| 3/23 | The Persistent Widow | Lk 18:1-8 | The widow asks the judge persistently | Pray persistently | Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer. (Rom 12:12) |
| 3/30 | The Pharisee and the Tax Collector | Lk 18:9-14 | The Pharisee prays proudly; the tax collector prays humbly | Be humble | In humility value others above yourselves. (Phil 2:3) |
| 4/6 | Jesus Eats with Zacchaeus | Lk 19:1-10 | Jesus befriends Zacchaeus and eats at his home | Tell all people about Jesus | Today salvation has come to this house, because this man, too, is a son of Abraham. (Lk 19:9) |
| 4/13 | Jesus Dies | Lk 23:26-49 | Jesus dies on the cross for our sins | Thank God for His sacrificial love | But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us. (Rom |
| 4/20 | (Easter) Jesus Is Risen | Lk 24:1-35 | Jesus is risen | Tell others about Jesus | He has risen! He is not here. (Mk 16:6) |
| 4/27 | Jesus Appears to His Disciples | Lk 24:36-49 | Jesus appears to His disciple | Witness for Jesus | You are witnesses of these things. (Lk 24:48) |
